## Minutes of a General Meeting held at *The South Hobart Community Centre* on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2007 at 8:00 pm.

Present: Seven (7) attendees

Minutes of the previous meeting: were read and confirmed.

Business Arising from the Minutes:

1. **162A Forest Road:** Leave on agenda.
2. **Environmental Protection Agency:** Lindsay Brinsdon reported that the EPA may be the body to overview Gunn's Tamar Valley pulp mill restrictions.
3. **Holy Trinity Church:** Lindsay has been circulating a petition which already has 2,600 signatures. There is strong community support. *The Hobart City Council* has given \$2,000.00 for a conservation study of the building.
4. **Southern Outlet Road Widening:** The Hobart City Council has discussed this with DIER recently. Up to \$560,000.00 has been allocated to the project. The Association's letter to the federal government department responsible for the original grants has not been answered in spite of three follow-up letters and one to the relevant minister.
5. **Cuthbertson's Tannery:** The Company was found guilty of polluting recently but was not fined.
6. **South Hobart Community Centre Facilities:** A letter of thanks was received from Elizabeth Brinsdon thanking the Association for the new trestle tables. Georgina ? has ~~lent~~ the Centre a new electric fire.
